

Highway 104 at Antigonish

PHASE I

Where is Phase I?

Phase I of the highway construction is 1.9 km west of Exit 31A to 0.6 km west of Exit 34 (total 7.9 km).

Construction of Phase I will occur between 2009 and 2012.

Timeline of Phase I

2009

- 2.94 km of highway construction (clearing, grading and gravel)
- Addington Forks Road Underpass bridge (structure)
- Interchange ramps, roundabouts and Addington Forks Road upgrade (grading)
- Beech Hill Road lowering, 0.7 km (grading)
- Beech Hill Road Hwy overpass bridges (structure)

2010

- 2.0 km of highway construction (grading and gravel)
- Interchange ramps and roundabouts at Beech Hill Road, 0.8 km (grading and gravel)
- Beech Hill Road, 1.1 km (paving)
- Beech Hill Road, Access Roads, 0.7 km (grading and gravel)

2011

- West River bridges (structure)
- Land Access Tunnel east of West River bridge (structure)
- Hwy 104, West River Bridges approaches, 0.27 km (grading)
- Access Road and Land Access Tunnel approach, 0.75 km (grading)
- 2.68 km of highway construction (grading)
- Hwy 104/Trunk 7 interchange ramps (grading)
- Trunk 7 highway overpass bridges (structure)



- Church Street extension tunnel (structure)
- Connection of Church Street extension and Kell Road, 0.2 km (grading and gravel)

2012

- Addington Forks Road realignment through interchange, 0.5 km (paving)
- 6.65 km of highway construction (paving)
- Addington Forks Road interchange ramps (paving)
- Trunk 7 interchange ramps (paving)
- Beech Hill Road interchange ramps (paving)
